About lecturer:

Jesus Crespo Cuaresma is a professor of economics at the Vienna University of Economics of Business, as well as the director of economic analysis at the Wittgenstein Centre for Demography and Human Capital and a consultant to the Austrian Institute of Economic Research, the Austrian Central Bank and the World Bank. His fields of research are macroeconometrics, economic growth, economic policy and forecasting. He has published extensively in such journals as Science, Journal of Applied Econometrics, Economica, Economic Inquiry, Population and Development Review, Oxford Bulletin of Economics and Statistics, Public Choice or Journal of Forecasting, just to name a few.



Abstract:

The presentation summarizes recent research on the effect of human capital on economic growth and political institutions. The research presented is based on a new global dataset of age-structured educational attainment data which enables us for the first time to assess the dynamics of human capital by age group. Our results emphasize the importance of education as a determinant of income growth and democratization processes.
